



1-2 semester study at ITS

We invite undergraduate and graduate students from all over the world to take 1-2 semester non-degree study at ITS. This program is usually called student mobility, student exchange, or study abroad program. This can be done with or without exchange agreement between ITS and students' home university,

Students can study for 1 semester with no tuition fee. However, if they want to extend their study to 2 semester, they have to pay tuition fee if their home university has no agreement with ITS.

internship

ITS provides opportunities for students from all over the world to have an internship experience at ITS laboratories (lab-based) or industries (industrial-based) that have relationship to ITS. Students may choose to do the internship for 1-4 months.

To register for the internship program, students have to write an internship proposal outlining work plan during the internship period.

For industrial-based-internship, students should nominate several companies as the target of internship and actively contact the companies themselves. In industrial-based-internship, international students will be team up with ITS students. Please be advised that due to Indonesian immigration laws, internship students from overseas are not eligible for payment during the internship period.

customized short program

In addition to our bi-annual international short course program, CommTECH (Community and Technological Camp). ITS is also willing to organize customized short-programs for minimum 15 participants based on specific request.

The program could be credit or non-credit program at any topic in ITS's expertises. Schedule, content, and course fee could be discussed to suit your need.
